### **Purpose/Principle:**

The College will develop and maintain an Integrated Pest Management plan (IPM), to be used to insure the safe and effective use of chemicals and exclusionary efforts of pests (rodents, insects, detrimental vegetation) on College property. The College will consult with county agencies and the state IPM coordinator, Oregon State University, while developing this plan. The Board of Education shall approve any changes to the plan made by the designated IPM Coordinator. The plan will be made available on the Facilities and Safety page on the College website and physical copies can be requested from the Office of Facilities and Public Safety.
